

SWIMMING POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

SANFORD ELKS LODGE NO. 1679

(Revised: 02/19/2020)

- 1. Pool facilities are for PAID-UP members of B.P.O.E. #1679 and their immediate families and limited house guests. The words “immediate family” shall mean your spouse and UNMARRIED children in your household. Up to four house guests per member will be admitted without charge when accompanied by a paid-up member or a member of his/her family. The words “house guest” shall mean any person or persons who resides out of the county and outside the jurisdiction of Sanford Lodge #1679, and who is visiting in the home of a member of Lodge #1679. ANYONE BRINGING UNAUTHORIZED GUESTS SHALL SUBJECT HIS/HER FAMILY TO SUSPENSION OF POOL PRIVILEGES.**
2. EVERYONE must sign the pool register before entering and upon leaving the pool.
3. Children under 10 years of age will not be permitted to use the pools unless supervised by a person 16 years or older.
4. No person over 8 years of age will be permitted to use the wading pool.
5. EVERYONE is required to shower before entering the pool.
6. Rowdyism will not be tolerated. Running on the pool deck is forbidden. All pool furnishings such as tables, chairs, etc., are to be kept behind the lines.
7. Beach balls, tubes, rafts, etc., will not be permitted. Approved safety equipment is acceptable and will be left to the lifeguard’s discretion.
8. Only one person will be allowed on the diving board at one time. Be sure diving area is clear before diving.
9. No swimming in the diving area.
10. No pets will be permitted inside the fenced in pool area.
11. Any person having a contagious disease, open sore, foot infections, or any infectious condition will not be admitted to the pool.
12. No glass containers allowed in or around the pool entrance. Suntan lotions, etc., must be in non-breakable containers.
13. Alcoholic beverages allowed only if purchased in Elks Lounge or Elks pool concession. No glass bottles.
14. If at any time the pool is in danger of becoming overcrowded, the lifeguards shall, at their discretion, refuse further admittance to the pool.
15. The lifeguards, or club are not responsible for articles left in the pool area.
16. Each member will be held responsible for his/her conduct and the conduct of his/her family and guests.
PLEASE SUPERVISE YOUR CHILDREN.
17. The lifeguards will be in complete control of the pool at all times.
18. The upper gate leading from the parking lot behind the Lodge will be open, so please use the parking areas for your convenience.
19. This is your pool for the enjoyment of all the Lodge members and their families. The rules are made for your protection and to increase the potential enjoyment of the pool. Please observe the rules and do not interfere with the lifeguards. You use the pool at your own risk. Our insurance is our lifeguards.
20. Horseplay in Bathrooms is strictly prohibited. It may result in termination of pool privileges.
