### **Proposed Bylaws Change**

To all Sanford Elks Members:

We have a need to change our by-laws at the Lodge. The Board is proposing a change in our dues. I assure you the board has looked at many alternatives before coming to the conclusion of an increasing dues. We have been fortunate at the Sanford Lodge that we have not had an increase in dues over the last 10 years. In the past year we have spent almost \$100,000 of unbudgeted expenses to replace worn out equipment around the Lodge. The HVAC unit in the Ladies Lounge was recently replaced, \$10,058.00 and the HVAC unit for the upstairs was replaced a couple weeks for \$48,053.00. At the pool, the pump room concrete ceiling / pool deck need to be replaced due to the deterioration resulting from the chemical we use for the pool. This project needs to be completed before we open the pool next spring. We are still working on final estimates, but we are looking in the range of \$40,000. There are also several other projects that we are evaluating and looking at the best timing for the Lodge to complete them.

So, the by-law change is requesting an increase in dues of \$54.00 starting 1 April 2024. Grand Lodge assessment is also increasing \$5.00 per member bring our annual dues to \$298.00 per member.

The following motions will be placed on the floor for change in our by-laws. This serves as a notice to all members that a vote will be taken at the business meeting of Sanford Elks Lodge 1679 at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, December 13, 2023.

#### Motion 1:

Article X, section3: The regular lodge dues shall be \$260.00 per year, which shall not include the Grand Lodge per capita fee and insurance assessment and State Association Dues.

• Formerly the dues were \$206.00 plus national and state per capita.

#### Motion 2:

Article X, section 4: Life member dues shall be \$41.00 per year, which shall not include the Grand Lodge per capita fee and insurance assessment and State Association Dues. Formerly the dues were \$31.00.




