Legacy Awards Application Deadline Is Approaching

All Elks should encourage their children and grandchildren who are graduating high school seniors to apply for the ENF Legacy Awards. It's a competitive \$4,000 scholarship that will be awarded to college-bound high school seniors to help them pay for college. Applications are **due online on February 5, 2024**.

For the 2024 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the order on or before April 1, 2021, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2021, is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member through March 31, 2024. Great-grandchildren are not eligible.

The Sanford Elks Lodge is proud to say that "Toys for Teens" and "Cleats for Kids" are grass root projects that we started in our community.






Ava Hayes and Sara Brewer were our personal shoppers for the Elks 2023 Toys for Teens Program for the two local high school.


