Thank You for Giving (This is why we Give)

I wanted to say thank you again for securing the grant to get the tablets and headphones for the teens at the Jaycee Burn Center. The trip was a success as always and the nurses always have some good stories about giving them out. One teen, after receiving them one morning, gave it back to the nurse that afternoon thinking it was just for the day. The nurse explained to them that it was for them to keep. They said they were very excited and grateful that someone would just donate something like that. Other stories are the same as far as using the tablets to keep in touch

with friends and family, playing games, and listening to music. Some of the nurses also say that they load a couple of educational apps on there to make sure they learn a few things too while recovering, lol!

But one story they told me in particular really got me and brought on tears of joy. A female teen had been there for about 6 months. They had hoped she would be there when we came so we could meet her but luckily, she got discharged to go home. They



said that she really used the tablet and headphones every day. Talking/keeping in touch with friends and family mostly. To the extent that being able to do that with the tablet gave her the spark to keep going everyday and get through her recovery.

Which from the beginning was one of my hopes for the tablet and headphones. To help give a little escape from the 4 walls they are stuck in and mental relief from any pain. Burn treatment/recoveries are very difficult and painful and the nurses say that with teens the tablets and headphones always work to aid in that. And as a Christian, I hope it aids them into reading the Bible and turning towards Jesus.

And like I have always said, the nurses are always genuinely grateful when the Sanford Elks Lodge donates these.

Also, a huge thanks for the toy drive! I have never had my truck that full. Whatever was done this year really worked. I think Chanda's weekly update helped it to grow this year.

Thank you for letting me do this again and I hope we are able to keep repeating it. This is the 7th year we have done this! And I ask for prayers for those in the Jaycee Burn Center for healing and finding Jesus.




Who Are the Elks?
