

Pool News - Important Vote on March 13

During an inspection of our pool facility, it was discovered that a retaining wall must be repaired before opening the pool. This involves getting structural engineers involved. The cost of this project will exceed \$25,000 which requires Grand Lodge approval. Our Grand Lodge requires this project be voted on by our membership. At our lodge meeting on February 28, a motion was made that we spend up to, but not exceed \$100,000 to compete the required repairs for our pool. We will vote on this motion during our lodge meeting on March 13. Please plan to attend this meeting and cast your vote so we can get the pool open this summer.



Jamariah Bell - State Hoop Shoot




